In connection with the Petition for Involuntary Assessment and Stabilization of the above-named substance abuser, executed by the undersigned and presented on this date to the above-styled Court under the provisions of Section 397 Florida Statutes, this is to acknowledge that prior to the acceptance and filing of such petition I/we are hereby being advised that the penalty under Florida Law relating to criminal responsibility concerning **knowingly** furnishing false information or proceeding without probable cause for believing that the subject person to be a substance abuser is as follows:

F.S. 837.02: Whoever makes a false statement, which he does not believe to be true, under oath in an official proceeding in regard to any material matter shall be guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in F.S. 775.082 or 775.083.

F.S. 775.082(3)(d): For a felony of the third degree, by a term of imprisonment not exceeding 5 years; and/or

F.S. 775.083(1)(c): Fine of \$5,000.00 when the conviction is a felony of the third degree.

I/We hereby affirm that such petition has been executed and is presented herewith in the best of faith and with probable cause on the part of the undersigned for believing the above-mentioned person to be a substance abuser.
