Marriage Ceremony Officiant Information Sheet

Pursuant to §741.07, Florida Statute, the following persons or officials have the authority to solemnize marriages within the State of Florida:

- Regularly ordained ministers of the gospel or elders in communion with some church or other ordained clergy
- All judicial officers, including retired judicial officers
- Notaries Public of this state

While the Clerk & Comptroller's Office is not required by law to officiate such services, it provides this list of persons who have expressed their availability to perform these ceremonies. The Clerk & Comptroller's Office makes no representation or warranties with regard to the persons listed, and only provides this limited forum as an informational service for the convenience of the public.
