**AGREED ORDER ON UNOPPOSED MOTION TO
DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

This Cause came to be considered upon the Unopposed Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records (*e-filed*: July 21, 2023) (“Motion”) filed by Plaintiff, Jett Florida Bells, LLC. After considering the Motion and being fully advised of the premises, upon the agreement of the Parties, and for the reasons set forth in the Motion, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. The Motion is GRANTED as set forth herein.
2. This case, currently pending before the Court, involves confidential and commercially sensitive business information of the parties and third parties.
3. The particular grounds under Rule 2.420(c) for determining the confidentiality of the court records specified in this Order are that confidentiality is required to “protect trade secrets” and “comply with established public policy set forth in the Florida or United States Constitution or statutes or Florida rules or case law[.]” Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(vi), (vii).

4. This Order does not determine to be confidential any party's name, the progress docket, or similar records generated to document activity in the case.

5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to maintain as confidential and under seal the following court record: (i) the entirety of Exhibit E to Plaintiff's Complaint for Injunctive and Other Relief (*e-filed*: July 10, 2023) and (ii) the entirety of Exhibit F to Plaintiff's Complaint for Injunctive and Other Relief (*e-filed*: July 10, 2023). Only counsel for the parties to this action and the parties themselves are permitted to view the confidential court record identified in this paragraph.

6. The Court finds that (i) the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Rule 2.420(c); and (ii) no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in Rule 2.420(c).

7. The Clerk of Court is directed to publish this Order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(4) of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.
