**Legal Resource Centers
Notice of Limitation of Services Provided**

The purpose of the Clerk of the Circuit Court's Legal Resource Centers is to assist individuals representing themselves (sometimes referred to as pro se litigants); not those who are already represented by a private attorney.

The personnel in the Legal Resource Center are not acting as your lawyer or providing legal advice to you. They are not acting on behalf of the court or any Judge. Additionally, they cannot provide you legal advice, tell you what your legal rights or remedies are, represent you in court, or tell you how to testify in court.

Legal Resource Center services are available to all persons who are or will be parties to a family law case, a residential landlord/tenant case, or a small claims case (**NOT** for criminal, traffic, expungement, guardianship, probate, real property, foreclosures, commercial landlord/tenant, civil claims over \$8,000, appeals, bankruptcy, and federal cases).

The information that you give to and receive from Legal Resource personnel is **NOT** confidential and may be subject to disclosure. If another person involved in your case seeks assistance from this Center, that person will be given the same type of assistance that you receive.

Consulting with a Legal Resource Center attorney is limited to assistance with court-approved forms and procedural information. If more detailed legal assistance is required, it is best to consult with your own attorney.

The Judge is not required to grant the relief requested in a form.
