
ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Petition for Order Approving Attorney’s Fee Contract is GRANTED. The Petition for Order Approving Attorney’s Fee Contract is hereby sealed pursuant to Rule 2.420(c)(8), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, and Rule 4-1.5(f)(4)(B)(ii) of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar.

Pursuant to Rule 2.420(e), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, the Court finds as follows:

- (A) Type of case: civil negligence/medical malpractice action;
- (B) Grounds for determining information is confidential: The information is deemed confidential pursuant to Rule 2.420(c)(8), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, and Rule 4-1.5(f)(4)(B)(ii) of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar.
- (C) No party’s name is deemed to be confidential;
- (D) The progress docket and/or similar record generated to document activity are determined to not be confidential;

- (E) Information determined to be confidential: the financial information contained in the Petition for Order Approving Attorney’s Fee Contract and the Authority to Represent (fee agreement) attached thereto;
- (F) Persons permitted to view the confidential information: the Petitioner, SUSAN MARTIN, and their attorney’s Rossman, Baumberger, Reboso & Spier, P.A., and J.P. Gonzalez-Sirgo, Esq.
- (G) The Court finds that: (i) the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c) of Rule 2.420, Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration; and (ii) no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c);
- (H) The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to publish this order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(5), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration.
