**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DETERMINE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon Defendants' Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records (the "Motion"), and the Court having reviewed the Motion and having been duly advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Defendants' Motion is **GRANTED**. The documents and records on the Court docket at document numbers 86, 89, and 90 are hereby deemed to be confidential and shall be maintained as such.

2. The court finds that: (i) the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.420(c); and (ii) no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c).

3. Specifically, in this personal injury case, the records sought to be determined as confidential comprise of Plaintiff's medical records and summaries of same, which are confidential under Section 456.057, Florida Statutes. See Fla. R. Gen. Prac. and J. Admin. Rule 2.420(c)(8).

The Parties are permitted to view the records that are the subject of the Motion. No parties' names are deemed confidential.

4. The clerk of the court is directed to publish the order in accordance with subdivision (e)(5).
